Spend three exciting days at the Netherlands Embassy in Stockholm, where you work with students from the Netherlands and with the support of experienced coaches to find creative solutions to a societal challenge around e-health. All participants are offered food, accommodation and travel.

Students from Uppsala University (Sweden) and University of Groningen (Netherlands) will join in the first ever edition of this e-Health Challenge. During three days in Stockholm, you will work in cross-university interdisciplinary teams on a real-world challenge around the theme of eHealth. With the current pandemic impacting every citizen and every employee in all sectors of industry, eHealth has become more viable and relevant than ever before.

The event is made up of the live meeting in Stockholm, with some digital preparation beforehand. No deep prior business knowledge is required. You will be introduced to key concepts of eHealth and provided with support on your proposed solutions from dedicated advisors throughout the process. The delivery team will be on hand to support you from start to finish, sharing tips and resources along the way!

Experiences of challenge-driven activities and/or innovation is a merit.
