- *KoF24*. A pre-study for Medfarm's part of the KoF24 evaluation was carried out during the spring. The pre-study will result in a proposal for a plan with directives for how the Disciplinary Domain will implement the KoF24 project. The proposed plan and directives for Medfarm's KoF24 evaluation must be ready for ON on 23 August 2023.
- *New Rules of Procedure*. Next week, the University Board is expected to decide on a change in the criteria for being considered a scientifically competent teacher at UU. The proposal includes an addendum to the definition of persons with scientific competence regarding adjunct professors and senior lecturers at the Faculty of Medicine.
- Investigation of research and collaboration support at Uppsala University. University Director Caroline Sjöberg has commissioned an external investigator (Karin Röding) to review how research and collaboration support at Uppsala University can be strengthened. The report has now been handed over to the Director and work continues. <u>Read more here.</u>
- *ATMP (Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products) centre*. A regional knowledge centre and contact point for implementation and development of the ATMP area is established at Uppsala University Hospital. - *Recruitment of new national Director for SciLifeLab.* Process to recruit a successor to Olli Kallioniemi has started.

Region Uppsalas forskningspris 2022

Bengt Sandén, Docent in Orthopaedics and Senior Consultant in the spine section, former Deputy Hospital Director and Chief Medical Officer at Uppsala University Hospital, has conducted pioneering research on spinal stenosis that has fundamentally changed the treatment principles for a large proportion of patients with spinal stenosis.

Anders Wanhainen, Professor of Vascular Surgery with combined employment, has pioneered the introduction of ultrasound screening of the aorta to detect early aortic aneurysms. The screening has now been introduced nationwide, starting in Uppsala, and is estimated to have extended the lives of 1000s of men since its inception.

Sten Rubertsson, Professor of Anaesthesiology with combined employment, is an internationally recognised researcher who has spent almost 40 years improving survival after cardiac arrest with preserved neurological function (quality of life). The focus is on improving the effectiveness of cardiopulmonary resuscitation but also intensive care after successful resuscitation.

Lena Wettergren, Nurse and Professor, receives the prize for her research in sexual and reproductive health in cancer and global health with research in East Africa. Lena leads the Fex-Can research programme, which examines the sexual and reproductive health of young adults with cancer.

Jonas Oldgren, Senior Consultant and Professor, receives the prize for his longstanding work in clinical coagulation research with innovative and very large studies that have contributed to a radical improvement in the treatment of the serious public health problem of atrial fibrillation.
