



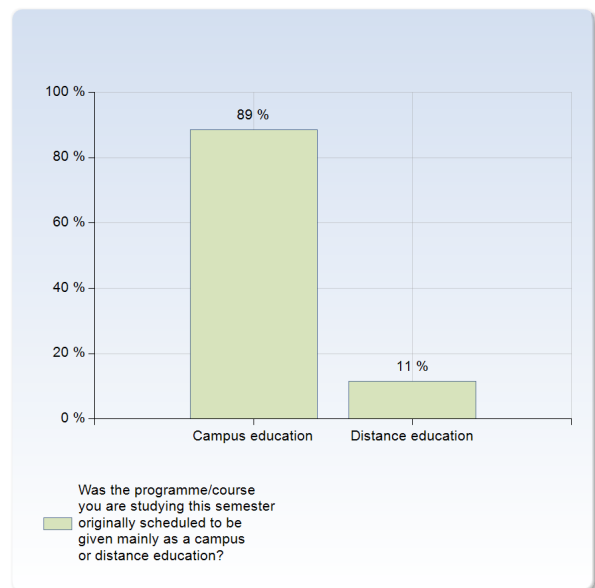

1 Was the programme/course you are studying this semester originally scheduled to be given mainly as a campus or distance education?

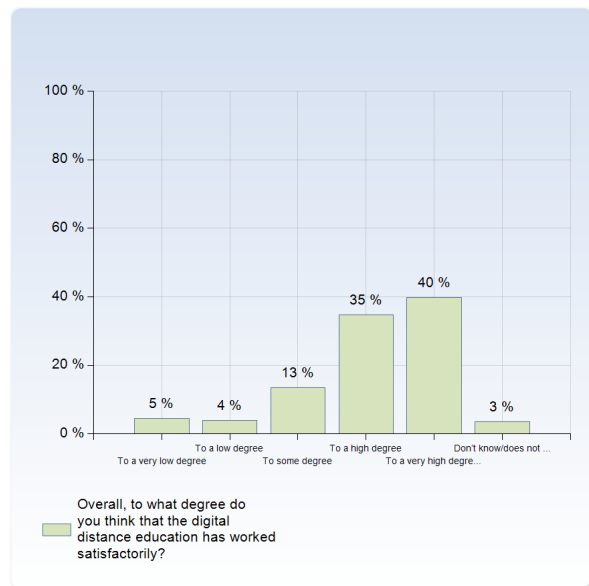

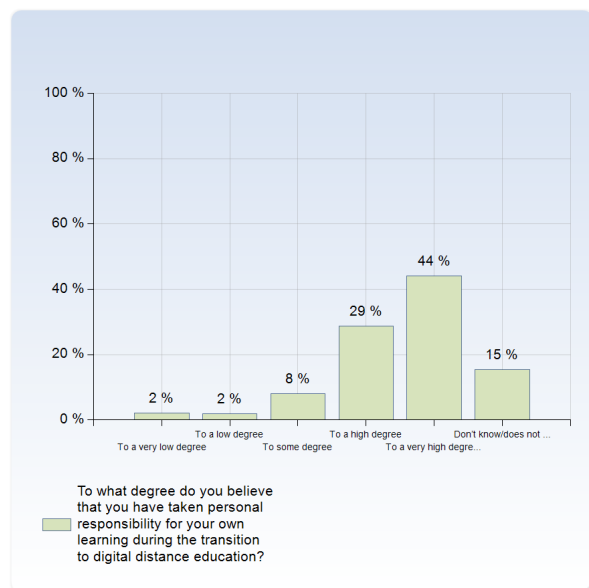

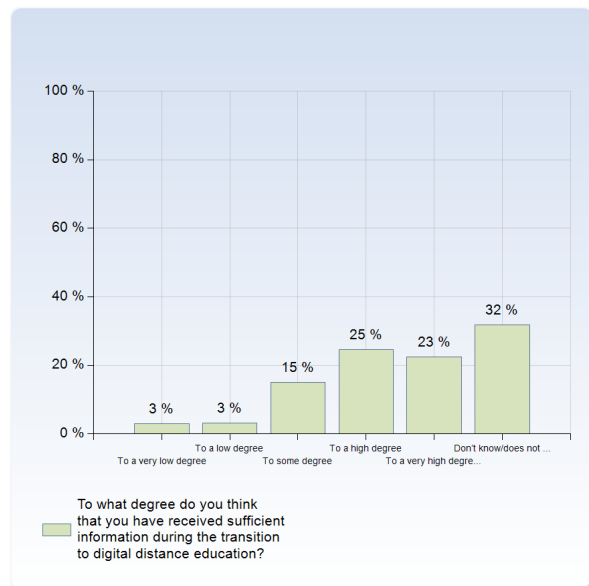

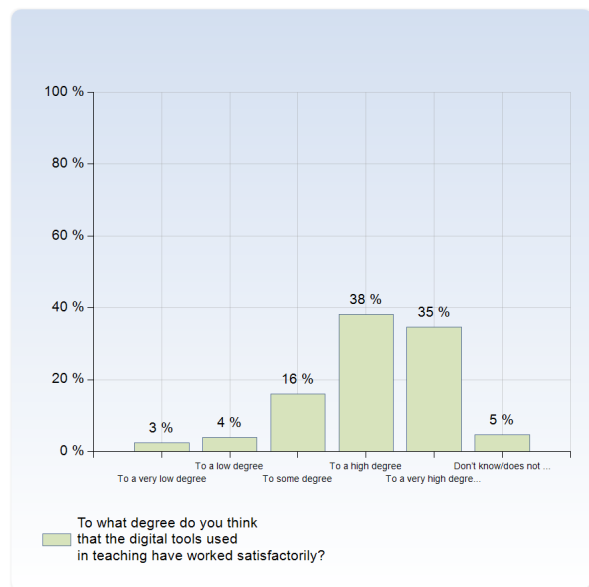

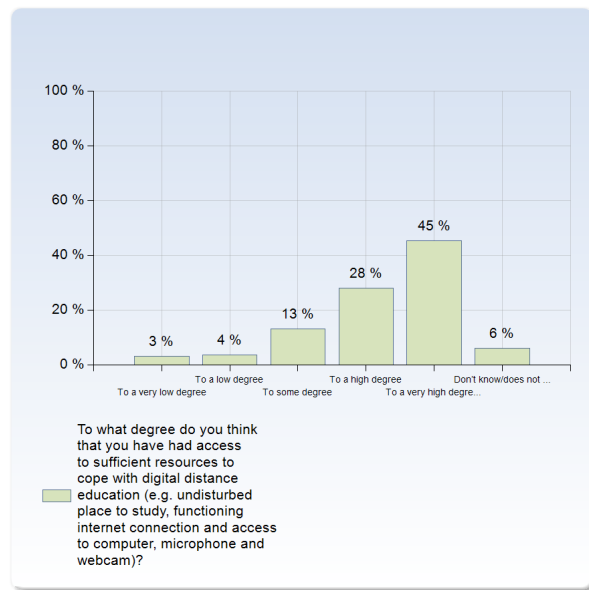

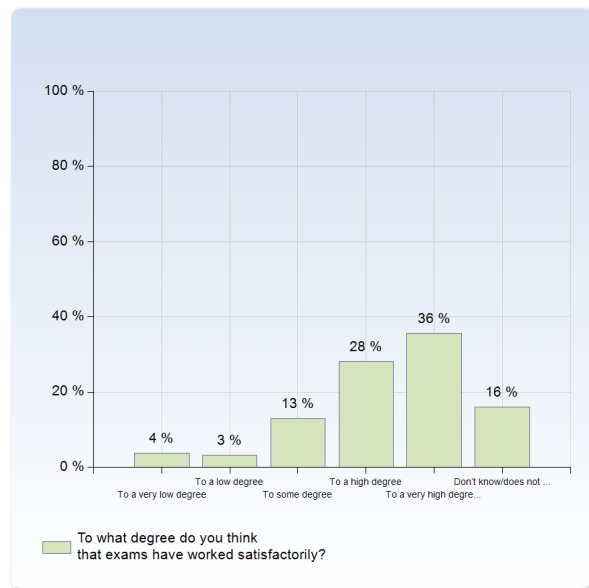

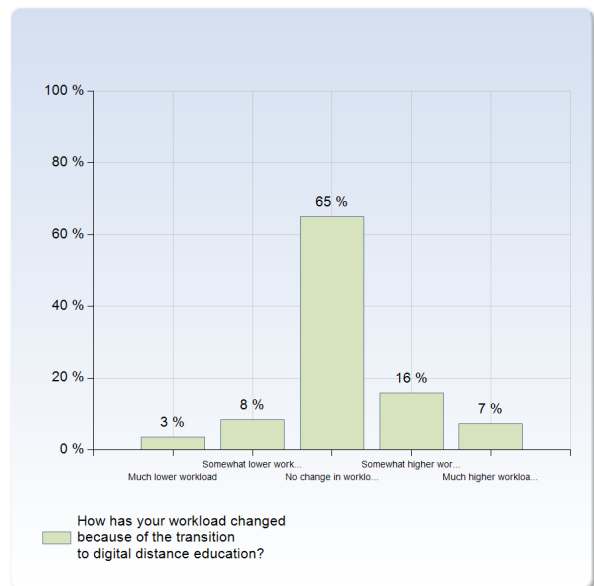

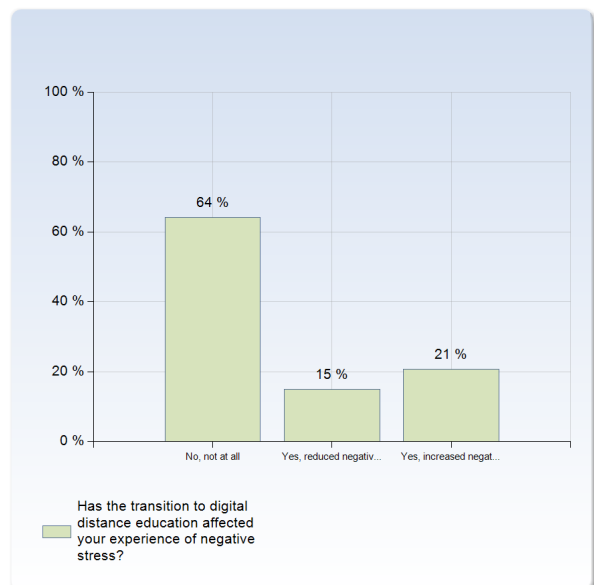
