### Provisions concerning third-cycle qualifications at Uppsala University – amendment

On 10 November 2009, the National Agency for Higher Education adopted new regulations and general advice on the English translation of Swedish qualifications (HSVFS 2009:2). Consequently, on 27 January 2010, the Association of Swedish Higher Education Institutions (SUHF) issued revised recommendations on English translations of the supplementary designations for general qualifications (REK 2010:2). Based on these recommendations, the following translations are hereby adopted for use in translating third-cycle qualifications at Uppsala University into English, when the degree application has been received after 31 January 2010:

<i>Teologie</i>	Doctor of Philosophy (Faculty of Theology)
<i>Juris</i>	Doctor of Laws
<i>Medicine</i>	Doctor of Philosophy (Faculty of Medicine)
<i>Farmacie</i>	Doctor of Philosophy (Faculty of Pharmacy)
<i>Filosofie</i>	Doctor of Philosophy
<i>Ekonomie</i>	Doctor of Philosophy
<i>Teknologie</i>	Doctor of Philosophy

With regard to the degree of *licentiat*, the National Agency for Higher Education has decided on the translation Licentiate. The above translations are therefore to be used, where relevant, substituting Licentiate for Doctor.

The decision in this matter was taken by the undersigned Vice-Chancellor in the presence of University Director Ann Fust, following a presentation of the matter by Head of Unit Margaretha Andersson. Deputy Vice-Chancellor Professor Kerstin Sahlin, Deputy University Director Jan Ivar Mattsson and President of the Uppsala Student Union Kristina Ekholm were also present.
