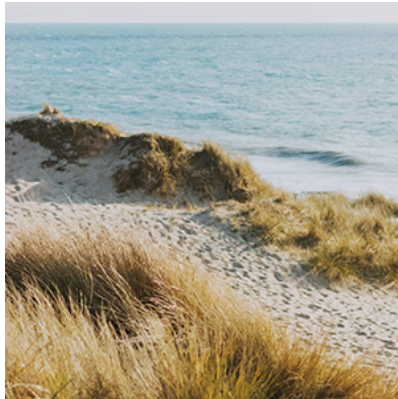

‘Green European Revisited - Environmental Behaviour and Attitudes in Europe in the Face of the Polycrisis’

This book is edited by Audrone Telesiene, Kaunas University of Technology; Matthias Gross, Helmholtz Centre for Environmental Research; and Markus Hadler, University of Graz. It examines how environmental attitudes and behaviours are evolving across Europe in an age shaped by the climate crisis, the covid pandemic, wartime, economic stress, energy and other crises – an emerging polycrisis. Drawing on decades of International Social Survey Programme (ISSP) Environment data, it traces shifts in worldviews and lifestyles. By combining longitudinal data, cross-national comparison, and sociological interpretation, the book offers an accessible portrait of how European societies understand and respond to environmental and related issues today.
